## S410 Blood Pressure System



### Skills:

- Palpation of radial pulse when cuff pressure is less than the selected systolic blood pressure
- Auscultation of Korotkoff sounds K1 through K4 (K5 is silence) between systolic and diastolic pressures
- Measuring systolic and diastolic pressures

## Arterial Arm Stick Kit

### Skills:

- Artery palpation is possible
- Percutaneous puncture sites in both brachial and radial artery

### Skills:

- Surgical implantation of CVC and PICC line
- Insertion of a catheter in external jugular and subclavian veins.
- Blood withdrawal
- Heparinization and fluid infusion
- Practicing dressing and suturing techniques
